

## Commonwealth Rent Assistance (CRA)

As an AnglicareSA tenant, you may be eligible for rent assistance from the Australian Government. It's called Commonwealth Rent Assistance (CRA) and you may be eligible if you receive:

- a pension OR
- a Centrelink payment OR
- Family Tax Benefit A

This is how it works.

**1** You tell Centrelink you have moved into an AnglicareSA property. They will assess whether you will receive Commonwealth Rent Assistance (CRA).

We will need to sign the Centrelink rent certificate.



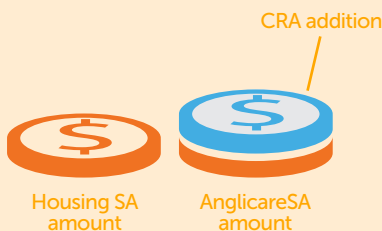
**2** If your CRA eligibility is approved, you'll need to sign a form so we can organise automatic payments from Centrelink. This is to make it as easy as possible for you.



**3** Your rent will be made up of your own payment (which is based on your income) PLUS the CRA funds.



**4** Your total rent is higher than for Government housing, but your "out of pocket" expense is still the same.



**5** As an AnglicareSA tenant, you will be part of our housing community and we will support you and your property in any way we can.



**6** Your CRA payment goes towards providing property upgrades which could include:

- Painting
- New kitchens
- New Bathrooms
