Level 1: Support Connection



Support Connection is time limited assistance to strengthen your ability to connect with informal, mainstream and funded supports, and to increase capacity to maintain support relationships, resolve service delivery issues, and participate independently in NDIS processes.

Your support coordinator can help you to:

- Identify support options (funded, mainstream and informal)
- Investigate options
- Understanding how your funding can be used
- Reach decisions about services
- Set up service agreements with providers
- Start your services and make sure things are going well

Your support coordinator will help you learn how to:

- Get your plan started and link to services
- Monitor the quality and money spent with services
- Manage how you use the funding in your plan
- Prepare for your review
