Watermelon and Kiwi Ice Blocks

- 170 g watermelon (chopped seeds removed)
- 2 tsp natural unrefined cane sugar
- 50 g kiwifruit (peeled)
- 1. Put the watermelon in a blender and whizz. Taste the mixture to see if you need to add any extra sugar; this will depend on the sweetness of the fruit. Add a little sugar at a time until the sweetness is to your taste.
- 2. Divide the watermelon mixture between the moulds until they are three-quarters full.
- 3. Insert the sticks with the stick-holders and place in the freez er. Freeze for about 3 hours or until the top of the mixture is quite frozen.
- 4. For the second layer, whizz the kiwi and 25ml of water in a blender, again adding sugar to taste.
- 5. Take off the stick-holders and pour the kiwi mixture into the moulds, leaving a 1cm gap at the top. Return the moulds to the freezer.
